

#### **FOREWORD**

#### The pianos:

As additional instrument all pianos need one or two golf- (or even heavier wooden) balls, going to be dropped on the open piano strings and picked up again when springing has stopped - used in measures 216-225.

Troughout the whole piece the pianos should play very much creating the background.

#### The choir:

Every member of the choir can throughout the whole piece use the techniques of inhales and exhales as she/he likes.

The whisperings and other speak-like matherials are scored on one-line-staff. If exact pitches occur, five-line staff is used. However, if whisperings occur on five-line-staffs, they are marked with notehead "x".

#### The pronounciation:

The pronounciation of the text should be NOT pronounced following English language. Please follow the next remarks:

If the vowels are separated with the slant (/), it means, do not make vowels sound together as a new vowel, but separate them, even if closed in one syllable.

For instance: Slo/a/th should be prenaunced (as English) slo:-aah-th (th as in bright "T" in "Thames").

If the phonem is parenthesed it means, the pharenthesed phonem is not the one on which the note should be sung.

For instance (s)I means the note should start with "s" and be sung on "l".

The text contains throughout the piece untypical hyphenation, for example the word "la-sl" consists those two syllables. Please follow the score.
