

Leonardo da Vinci: Nuvoli sotto la luna (Clouds under the Moon)

Il nuvolo che si trova sotto la luna è più scuro che qualunque altro, ed i più remoti sono più chiari, e la parte del nuvolo ch'è trasparente dentro ed infra gli estremi di esso nuvolo, par più chiara che alcun'altra simile parte ch'è nelle trasparenze de' nuvoli più remoti; perchè in ogni grado di distanza il mezzo dei nuvoli si fa più chiaro, e le lor parti chiare si fanno più opache rosseggianti di mortificato rosso; e gli estremi delle loro oscurità entranti nella trasparente loro chiarezza sono di termini fumosi e confusi; ed il simile fanno gli estremi delle loro chiarezze che terminano coll'aria. Ed i nuvoli di piccola grossezza son tutti trasparenti, e più inverso il mezzo che negli estremi, ch'è colore morto rosseggiante in colore rozzo e confuso. E quanto i nuvoli sono più discosti dalla luna, il loro lume è più albo, che avanza intorno all'ombrosità del nuvolo, e massime di verso la luna, e di verso la nigredine e poco albore, perchè in esso penetra la oscurità della notte che si mostra nell'aria.

*... which at night seem to surround the moon, of various sizes,
... ed by various gradations in the densities of the vapours which exist
... moon and our eyes. And of these halos the largest and least red is caused
... the second, smaller one, is higher up, and looks redder because it is seen
... as they are higher they will appear smaller and redder, because, between
... vapour. Whence it is proved that where they are seen to be reddest,*


