




Instructions for performance

General

I would like the piece to be rhythmically as fluent as possible. It would help to play the piano part – when there are no accents or dots – without accents, softly and musically fluently. In general use pedal when it's needed. I would like to emphasize the value of dynamics. Try to find balance between violin and piano and please follow the dynamic markings.

Violin



- the whole beginning passage (three crotchets) is an accelerando (do not make accel. it is been written in)
- -especially the third crotchet is not to be played strictly rhythmically as written, try to smooth it in order to make it fluent and sounding if it were written as on the second line of this example
- do not emphasize the second half of the third crotchet (=the beginning of the semiquaver triplet)

Start the glissando immediately from the note the line starts from, f.ex. looking at previous example the glissando starts from the Glissando beginning of the fourth crotchet.

Piano

Use pedal sparingly unless there are markings to do otherwise. Pedal

SOS. = sonstenuto pedal




- the piano part has a lot of this kind of rhythmic material. Unless it is marked otherwise in the dynamics or articulation the semiquaver in this kind of passage is never to be stressed
- I have shown this with a little diminuendo marking. It's to be similar throughout the whole composition.




