NOTES ON PERFORMANCE

FLUISCE is written for the following percussion:

player 1) Glockenspiel, 2 octaves crotales

player 2) Vibraphone w/o motor

player 3) Vibraphone w/o motor

player 4) 4 oct. Marimba

player 5) 5 oct. Marimba

The set-up of the mallet instruments is left to the performers. The pedal markings have usually been left out. The vibraphones should pedal according to the acoustics of the performance venue.

The most important thing for the mallets is that they sound completely in balance with each other. The sticks for the vibraphones should be the same, and use sticks on the marimba which produce the best sound for the ange. The mallet instruments should sound as one large instrument so that the harmonies are in balance. This is most difficult for the low marimba.
