## Performance instructions for the work

### Instrumentation

Flute, steel string guitar, viola

### Microintervals

$\text{f}^{\#}$  =  $\frac{1}{4}$ -tone upward,  $\text{f}^{\# \#}$  =  $\frac{3}{4}$ -tone upward

$\text{d}^{\flat}$  =  $\frac{1}{4}$ -tone downward,  $\text{d}^{\flat \flat}$  =  $\frac{3}{4}$ -tone downward

$\blacktriangledown$  = very sharp accent

### For the flute

$\text{P}^{\circ}$  = harmonic tone

$\text{T}$  = tongue-ram

$\text{T}$  = air-blowing sound



### For the guitar

The instrument should be tuned as follows:



The pitches in the score, including harmonics, do not indicate the audible results (this applies to the strings I, IV & V) but the tones to be stopped in the indicated strings.

= pluck the string(s) with the finger nail

= indicate the string(s) that should be plucked

= strings topped by the metal slide tube

= harmonic tone

= play with plectrum (pluck or scrape as indicated)

s.p. = sul ponticello

$\Rightarrow$  saddle = scrape with the tip of the slide along the strings towards the saddle

= circular slide motion

= "Bartók" pizzicato

= rub/pull along the string(s) with the super ball stick (holding by stick)


$\Rightarrow$  = from sul pont. towards to fingerboard

⇒ s.t. = towards to sul tasto


"wheezy" = hold the string tightly between the finger tips and drag rapidly




= indicate the place and direction between the bridge and the fingerboard



= from near the saddle towards to bridge



w/(s) = rub/pull at the table of the instrument with the super ball (holding by ball)



= indicate the place and direction at the table of the instrument

at the string(s) between the tuning

metal spring

### For the viola



= bow lies on the open strings near the edge of the fingerboard, stick pressed into hair



= press the bow strongly against the strings, turn the bow fast at the given direction

flaut. = flautando

ric. = ricochet



br. = on the bridge


w/ = pizzicato with the fingernail

= "saw", exaggerated bow motion



= circular bow motion


