Turun kaupunginorkesterin tilaus, kantaesitys Sigyn-sali 22.2.-97

Säveltäjä kertoo teoksestaan:

"Huilukonserttoni syntyi Turun Kaupunginorkesterin soolohuolistin Ilari Lehtisen innnoittamana kiihkeän sävellysperiodin aikana talvella 96-97. Olen hakenut teokseeni ulkomusiikkilisia vaikuttavia huiluun liittyviä myyteistä ja paikoin kuultavissa olevista etnisistä tunnelmista, asteikoista ja rytmeistä. Koska huili on soolosoittimena melko helposti peittäävissä orkesteripauhun alle, olen orkestroinut koko teoksen läpi kuultavasti ja selkeästi. Orkesterin nousut ajoittuvat lähes poikkeuksetta paikkoihin, missä soolohuilun replikit eivät ole pääosassa, mutta niinkuin solistikonsertossa kuuluukin olla tämän teoksen selkäranga on tietysti solistin kässissä. Olen antanut Ilari Lehtiselle vapaat kädet kadenssimateriaalin käsitteilyyn, ja olen toisaalta saanut häneltä viimeistelyvaiheessa korvaamattomia väritysvinkkejä ja ideoita.

Teoksen ensiosa on nimensä mukaisesti myyttinen ja käyttää hyväkseen soittimen salaperäisiä väritysmahdollisuuksia. Osa on myös kestoltaan ja taitteiden määrältään mittavin. Osaa hallitsee huilun ensimmäisen motiivin temaattinen materiaali. Vastakohtaiset ainekset, kuten tiukan pulssimusiikin suhde vellovampaan tekstuuriin, muodostavat tämän osan dramaturgisia vastavoimia. Toinen osa perustuu lyyriseen yön sointiin. Hieman leikittelevä aihe saa vastakohdakseen ekspressiivisen ja laulavan melodia-aiheen joka soi vuorotellen huilulla, trumpetilla ja jousilla. Kolmannen osan energinen pulssi taas vie kuulijan tanssillisen rituaalin pyörteisiin. Soolohuilun päätteema on sukua niille motiiveille, joita käytin kamarimusikkiteoksessani *Autumn Concerto*.

Huilukonserttoni kolmas osa on lyhyt ja ytimekäs, mutta antaa solistin vielä kerran kadenssissa käytää soittimen paljon ilmaisevia, monikerroksisia ja virtuoosisia sointimahdollisuuksia."

Verket har beställts av Åbo stadsorkester och uruppförs i Sigynsalen 22.2.1997.

Dirigent: Hannu Lintu

Solist: Ilari Lehtinen

Kompositören berättar om sitt verk:

"Min flöjtkonsert kom till under en hetsig kompositionsperiod vintern 96-97 och är inspirerad av Åbo stadsorkesters soloflöjtist Ilari Lehtinen. Jag har använt mig av intryck från andra världar än musikens, t.ex. myterna kring flöjen, och ställvis hörs också etniska stämningar, skälör och rytmer. Emedan flöjen som soloinstrument mycket lätt överröstas av orkestern, har jag orkestrerat hela verket på ett klart och transparent sätt. Orkesterstegringarna infaller nästan utan undantag på sådana ställen där soloflöjtens repliker inte har huvudrollen. Men eftersom verket är en solistkonsert, är det givetvis solisten som är dess ryggrad. Jag har gett Ilari Lehtinen fria händer att hantera kadensmaterialet. Av honom fick jag gengåld oersättliga nyanseringstips och idéer i det skede då jag lade sista handen vid arbetet."

Verkets första sats är mytisk, sitt namn likmäktigt, och här utnyttjas de möjligheter till hemlighetsfull nyansering som instrumentet erbjuder. Också vad längden och antalet avsnitt beträffar är första satsen längst. Den behärskas av det tematiska materialet i flöjtens första motiv. Motsatta element, t.ex. den strikta pulsmusikens relation till den mer fritt svallande texturen, bildar dramaturgiska motvikter i denna sats. Andra satsen baserar sig på nattens lyriska klang. Det något lekfulla motivet ställs i motsats till ett expressivt och sjungande melodimotiv, som framförs turvis av flöjen, trumpeten och stråkarna. Tredje satsens energiska puls äter tar lyssnaren med i rituella dansvirvlar. Soloflöjtens huvudtema är besläktat med de motiv som jag använt i mitt kammarmusikverk Autumn Concerto. Tredje satsen i min flöjtkonsert är kort och kärnfull, men ger solisten möjlighet att i kadensen än en gång utnyttja instrumentets mycket uttrycksfulla, flerbottnade och virtuosiska klangmöjligheter."
