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Lentamente for alto recorder mouth piece and audiotrack (2014).

Explanation of the score symbols.

-Numbers below the notes (1-5) indicates exhaling or inhaling pressure (1 = as low pressure as possible, 5 = as powerful as possible). Doesn't always mean dynamics.

-Trill 1 (in the beginning) means oscillating sound produced by damping the mouth piece and blow to the instrument with certain pressure. Creates strong tremolo/trill like sound.

-Trill 2 (in the end) means oscillating sound when you put your finger slightly in front of the ramp to cover the air column a little. Creates weak tremolo/trill like sound. (pic 5). Circular breathing in the end if possible.

Symbol **P** (in the beginning) = damp the mouth piece with your palm. (pic 1).

Symbol **F** (like in measure 19) = damp the ramp of the mouth piece with your fist. (pic 2).

Symbol **O** (like in measure 27) = no damping, all holes open.

Symbol **F1** (like in measure 35) = finger slightly in front of air column. (pic 3).

Symbol **P1/F2(4)** (after the audiotrack solo) = damp the mouth piece end with palm and tip of the mouth piece with your finger. (pic 4). (4) indicates amount of closeness of the damping the tip. (0) is totally open and (5) is totally closed. In these parts you need to blow into the ramp of the mouth piece.

Symbol **O/F2(4)** = no damping at the palm side. Tip side damping as previous.

Symbol **P1 flap** = hit the palm to the end of mouth piece creating percussive "plop" sound.

Symbol **F2 flap** = hit the tip of the mouth piece with your finger creating percussive "plop" sound.

During the audiotrack solo, sit down and close your eyes. After the audiosolo, stand up and continue. If possible the lights should be put off during audiotrack solo. When recorder player starts again, lights should be weaker than in beginning.

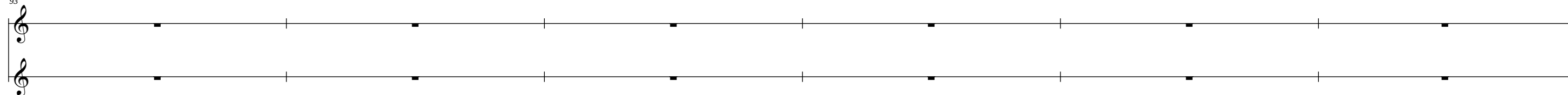

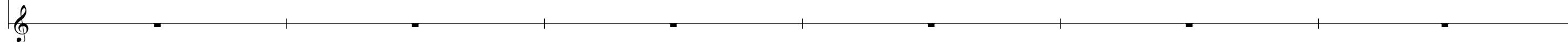
