

Instructions for DEDICATO

12 players

Score in C

Instruments:

F=flute (mp=mouthpiece alone)

K=clarinet in B (Ar=alto recorder, mp=mouthpiece)

C=horn in F

T=trumpet in B (sempre con sordino, harmon mute)

P=percussion(V=vibraphone, sempre senza motore, LTT=Large

tom-tom, WB=woodblock, X=xilophono,

two small glasses, half filled and empty respectively)

G=guitar(amplified with a contact microphone)

Pf=grandpiano

and a solo string quintet(M=mandolino)

Most of the symbols used in the notation are generally known. Explanations are provided for some of the more obscure ones:

p.25 Fmp+Kmp:relative pitch.

V =plectrum

10 cm { Denza tono

the piano string is touched lightly about 10cm from the end and the finger is slided on the string according to the indicated pattern.

Ib. = legno battuto

the string is touched lightly like in playing harmonics, and slided on the string as the notation shows.

the fourth, fift and sixth strings are struck with the cup-part of a teaspoon at the indicated place (you can see a graph of the strings on the left). The strings are lightly damped.



p.27

=the highest possible cluster that can be played with the fist.

p. 28

=make a glissando on A-string starting from the highest possible pitch and not going more that about a third from it.




=let a metal tube to jump freely on the indicated string.

p.31



=pressing the finger firmly against the fingerboard. Interrupt wit pizzicati (the glissando keeps going) Never play notes in parentheses.



=slide a metal ruler along the strings pressing firmly. The sound must be terrible.

p. 68

=press the indicated strings at the indicated place while playing on the strings the notated figures.

TON ONO MONONONON

=play the thin glasses with a pencil or a very light stick.

suspended symbal, prepared with a chaim, played with a metal beater.
