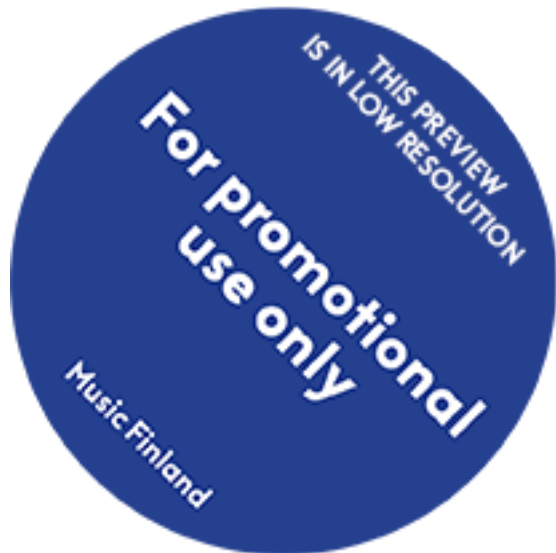

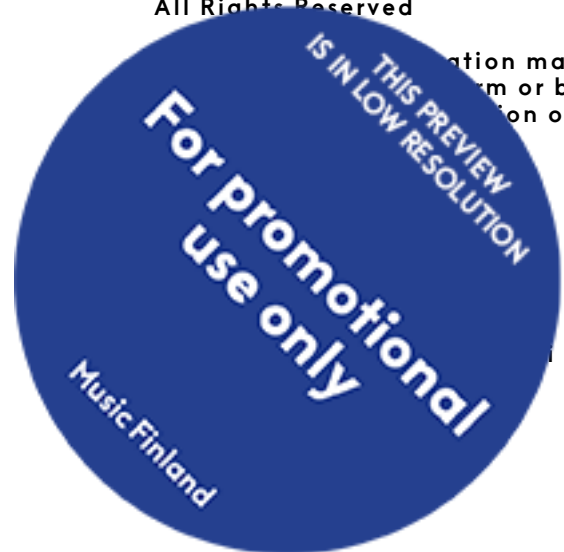

The relative position Horizontally represents the duration of each letter.
