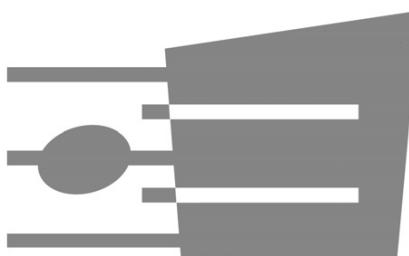

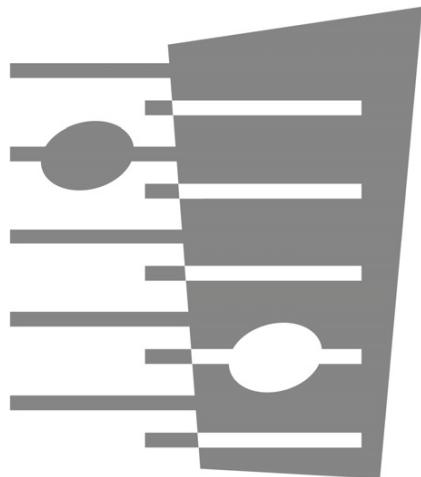

JEAN SIBELIUS

Overture in E major

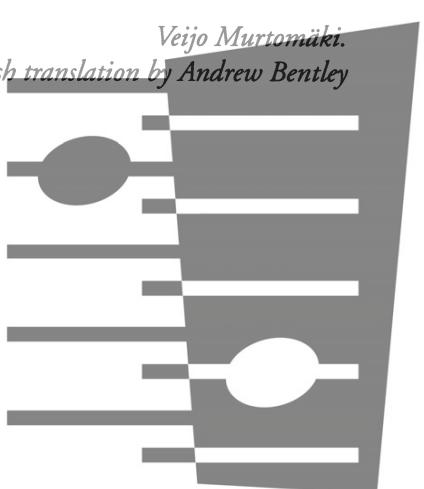
Sibelius's metamorphosis into first and foremost an orchestral composer was as successful as it was unexpected. There had been nothing to indicate that this young violinist, author during the 1880's of some fifty student works in chamber music genres, was destined to be the "man of the orchestra" that he subsequently became. He had hardly even heard much in the way of orchestral music before a period spent in Berlin and Vienna 1889-91, but in the latter city, under the guidance of Karl Goldmark – though limited to a few consultations – he became acquainted with the mysteries of orchestral writing. Performances by Viennese orchestras of Beethoven, Bruckner and Wagner were first-class and probably had a inestimable effect on extending in leaps and bounds the young composer's knowledge of the orchestra. Nevertheless one cannot but wonder that Sibelius, at this early stage and in his first ever orchestral compositions, the Overture in E major (Sibelius's original title was Ouverture) and Scène de Ballet, manoeuvres in the orchestral environment with such fluency and confidence.

The first signs of the still germinating E major overture date from December 1890. Early the following year (10.2.1891) Sibelius writes to his beloved Aino: "I intend to work in a new form, some kind of suite or actually a symphony. It begins with an overture which immediately establishes the mood... The overture is already in my head: waftily spring-like and full of love. The second theme is You yourself, tender and feminine but also passionate." Goldmark criticised the overture for being "too far-fetched"; he wanted to hear more depth of meaning in the themes, though he thought that the second theme was a good one. When Kajanuus and his orchestra premiered the work in Helsinki 23.4.1891, members of the professional musical community cabled the composer – according to Kajanuus's own account – with the words, "The overture resounded marvellously. You are a man of rare talent." And so the way was paved to Sibelius becoming an orchestral composer.

The Overture in E major is not originally Sibelian in style throughout. Bruckner and Wagner loom large in the background, especially with regard to its sonata form and the handling of the orchestra. On the other hand there is much in the piece which was to become essential Sibelius, and there are hints at *Kullervo* and *Lemminkäinen*, in other words plainly in the direction of symphonic working. The rhythm and melody of the main theme lends it a typical Finnish "sleigh-ride" atmosphere and is the probable reason for the work's subtitle, "A wolf hunt in Siberia", which appears on some of the parts and may originate with Sibelius himself. More characteristic however is the runesong-like second subject in the Aeolian minor which is in stark contrast with the generally boisterous tone of the work and lends it dark, melancholy undertones; it has the almost fatalistic shades of *Kullervo*, yet to be written. The overture also sees Sibelius using a theme with a falling fifth to achieve thematic synthesis, itself a pointer to nothing less than the Third Symphony.

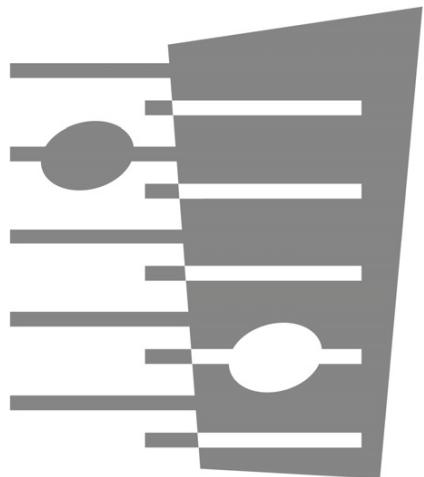

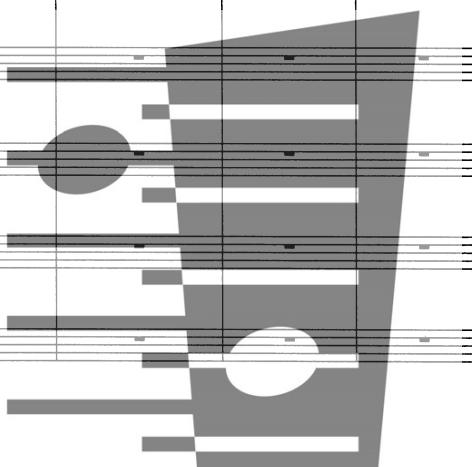

Editorial Comments

The present edition of the score follows the composer's manuscript (Helsinki University Library Cat. No. 0415). Some articulations and dynamic markings taken from the fair copy by Lauri Nissinen (Finnish Music Information Centre Cat. No. 9954), reconstructed from the parts in 1943, have been incorporated. The upper line of French horns (Cor. 1., 2.), originally *in E*, has been transposed to be *in F*. All the copyist's errors occurring in Nissinen's fair copy have been left uncommented in those cases where the composer's manuscript is correct. The following additions and corrections have been made with respect to the composer's manuscript:

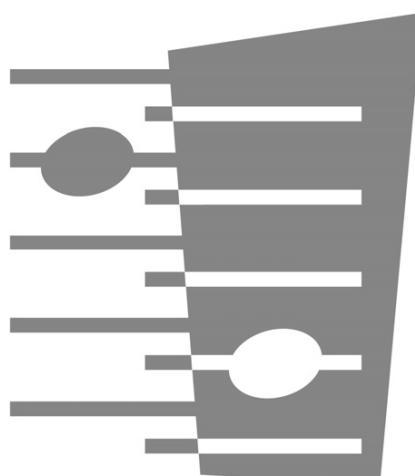
Bar nos.

- 19-21 The slurs above this figure in the woodwinds (crotchet tied to the first note of the following four semiquavers) were not consistent in the composer's manuscript. In most cases they are missing, which is unlikely to be a mistake since the slurs over the same figure in the strings have been carefully marked. - 172-178 The number of woodwinds employed in this bar is unclear. Originally all woodwind pairs were notated on the same staff, but neither $\grave{A} 2$ nor I° is indicated in the MS. The clarinet part in b. 170 has $\grave{A} 2$, and the bassoons have $\grave{A} 2$ in b. 170, though it is not clear how long this is meant to apply. Several interpretations are possible which will keep the balance between the two polyphonic lines (Vl. II and Vle). In this edition all the woodwinds play $\grave{A} 2$. This alternative has been chosen in the score and parts so as to allow the performers any possible choice. The final decision is left to the conductor's discretion.

- 277 The fifth Aflat-E flat in Cor. 3., 4. has been changed enharmonically to G sharp-D sharp for the sake of convenience in reading the score.
- 282 Enharmonic changes made to the first and fourth beat of Fl. 2 and Ob. 2:
F double-sharp replaced by G natural, E double-sharp → F sharp.
- 283 F double-sharp in Fl. 2 and Ob. 2 has been changed enharmonically to G natural.
- 314 Slurs added to all woodwinds.
- 319; 321 *mf* added to Piatti.
- 320 *p* added to Trlo.
- 333 The abbreviated way of notating the Timp. has been treated as a semiquaver rhythm (not a tremolo) as played by the other instruments.
