**Max Savikangas** (s. 1969) valmistui musiikin maisteriksi Sibelius-Akatemiasta vuonna 1998 opiskeiltuaan musiikin teoriaa, sävellystää, alttoviulunsoittoa (A-kurssitutkinto vuonna 1997) ja elektroakustista musiikkia. Hänen on säveltänyt kolmisenkymmentä teosta: instrumentaalikamarimusiikkia, elektroakustisia sävellyksiä ja näiden yhdistelmiä. Alttoviulistina Savikankaan kiinnostus kohdistuu nykymusiikin esittämiseen sekä improvisaatioon. Kamarimuusikkona ja sooloalttoviulistina Savikangas on ollut kantaesittämässä useita koti- ja ulkomaisia sävellyksiä, viimeksi hän herätti huomiota 24.11.2002 Osmo Tapio Räihälän alttoviulukonserttona *Håkan Berglassa* solistina. Savikangas on Uusinta-kamariyhteen perustajajäseniä.

Säveltämisen ja alttoviulunsoiton lisäksi Savikangas on kiinnostunut monitaiteellisista projekteista, joissa usein käytetään teknologiaa työkaluna. Tärkeänä yhteistyökumppanina näissä projekteissa on ollut kuvataiteilija Teemu Mäki.

Käpyrauhassilmä sisältää lausuttuja viitteitä merkillisen ranskalaisen filosofi ja kirjailija **Georges Bataille** (1897-1962) samannimiseen tekstiin *L'Anus Solaire* (suom. Tiina Arppe, Gaudeamus Kirja 1998).

Teos on sävelletty suoraan stemmoiksi. Kunkin soittajan tehtävä on soittaa omaa stemmaansa omassa tempossa, mutta samalla hänen tulee kuitenkin seurata muiden antamia kohtaamispaijkojen signaaleja tai itse antaa niitä muille. Sorsapilli solo on puhelaulun tapaan säveltasojen suhteen viitteellisesti notatoitu, ymmärrettävistä syistä.

Composer-viola player **Max Savikangas** (b. 1969) graduated from the Sibelius-Academy in 1998 after studying music theory, composition, viola playing and electroacoustic music. He has so far composed some thirty works, some on them instrumental chamber music, others electroacoustic and others combination of the two. In addition to composing and playing the viola he has been involved in multidisciplinary co-projects using sound, image and information technology. Many of these projects have been realised in partnership with the young Finnish visual artist *Teemu Mäki*. *L'Anus Solaire* contains recited references to the similarly titled text of the peculiar French philosopher and author Georges Bataille (1897-1962).

The music is written directly into performing parts. Each player plays their own parts in their own tempo, but at the same time they must follow the signals from each other and give them to the others. The duck whistle solo is, like a recital, notated only allusively, for reasons that are quite understandable.
