Hammered Dulcimer (*equipped with glass and cloth*)
(*orig. written for a 12-stringed, single-bridged diatonic*)
tuning (bridge divides p5ths):

left: g', a', bb', c'', d'', e'', f#'', g#'', a'', bb'', b'', c'''

right: c', d', eb', f, g', a', b', c#'', d'', eb'', e'', f''



In the *senza misura* section starting in b. 117, the space between two boxed numbers is not longer than 10 seconds. Also, the accidentals apply only to the note they directly precede. Some naturals may have been added as reminders.

The tempo alterations in the boxed sections are independent of the other player.

Special playing techniques have been explained in the score.






